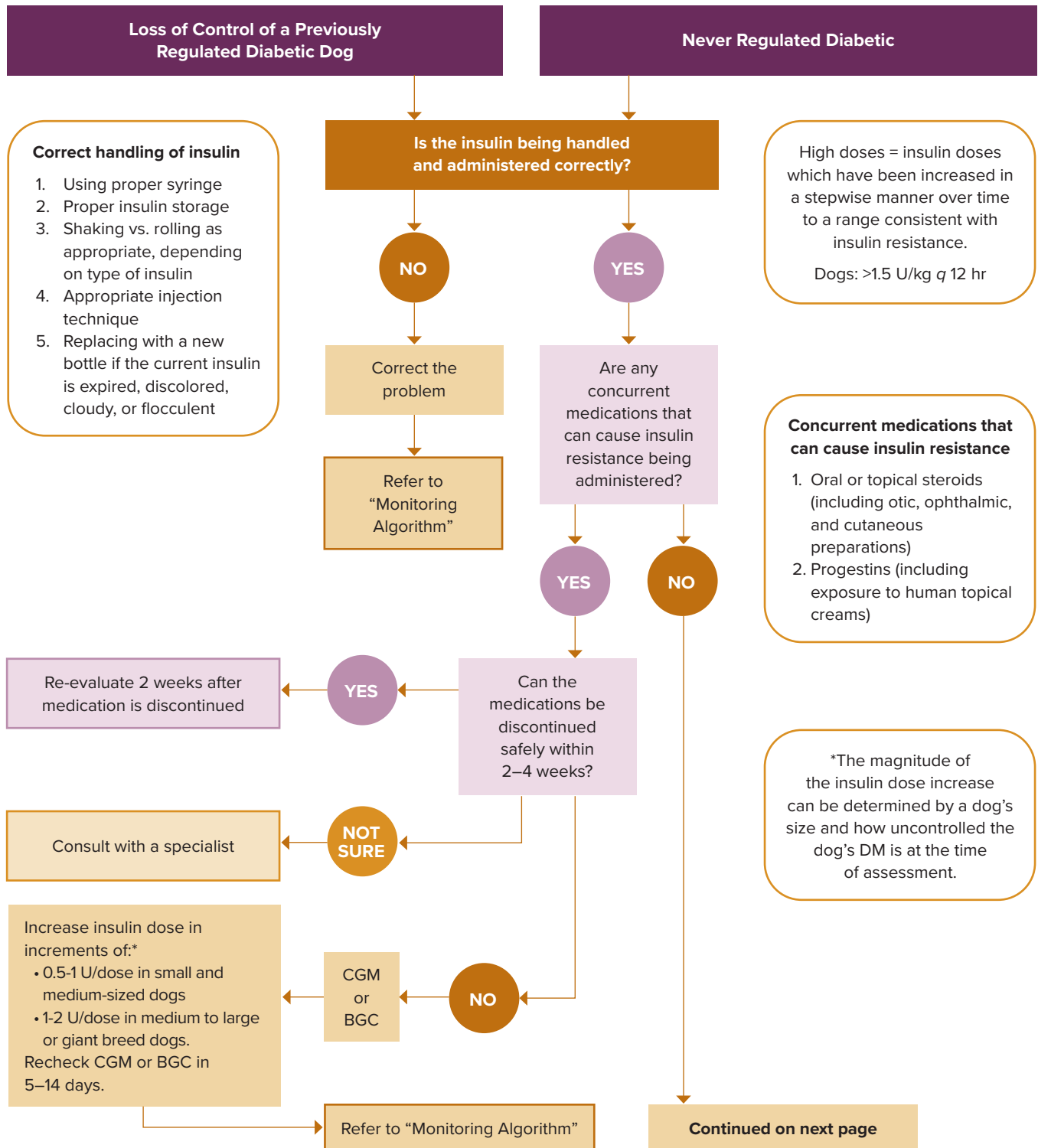

Troubleshooting Diabetic Dogs Receiving High Doses of Insulin

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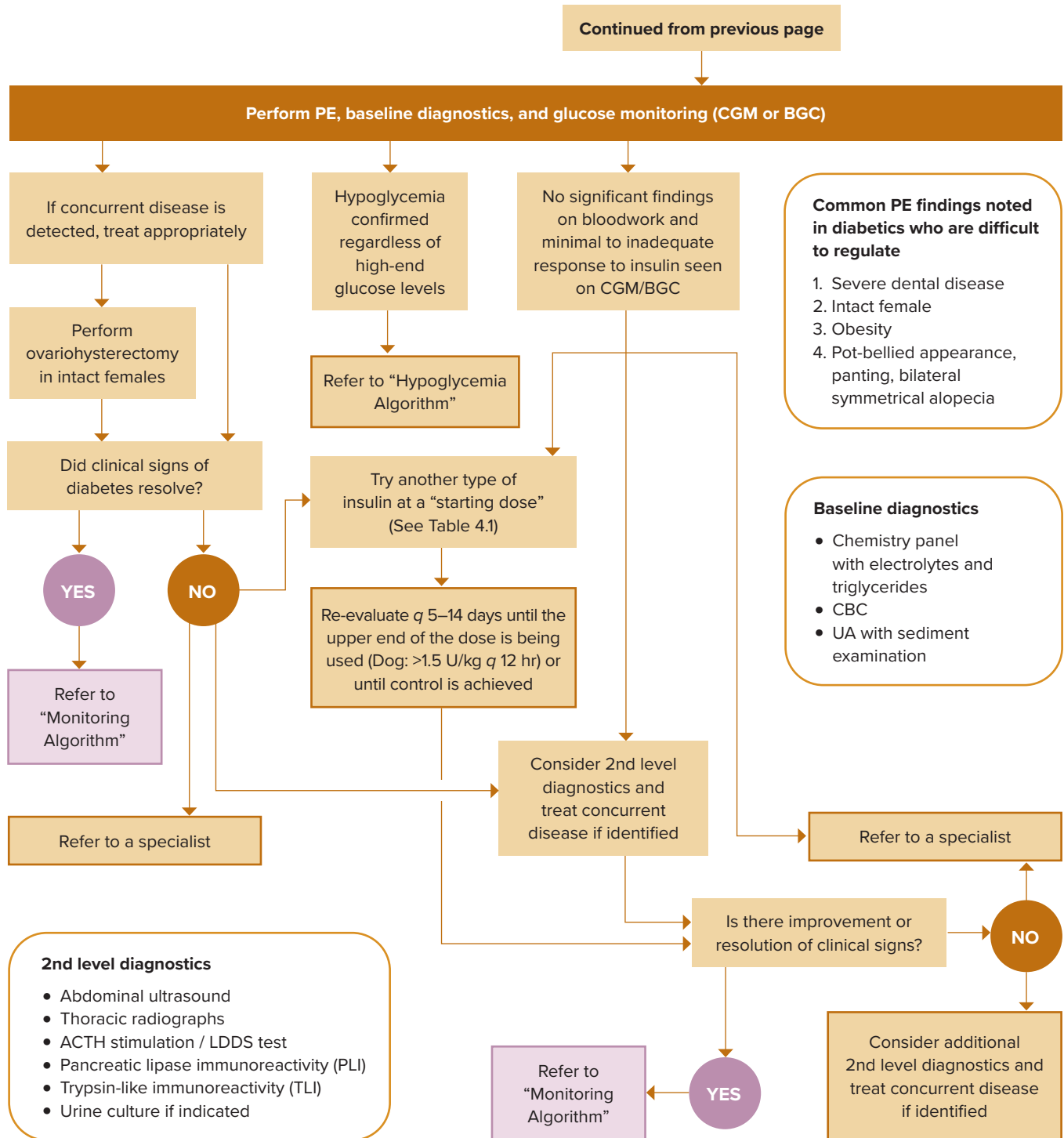


FIGURE 11.2, CONTINUED
